



# Criteria for Japan

---

1. Applicants should demonstrate a **strong aptitude in the Humanities** and **demonstrated interest in Japanese culture.**
2. This opportunity is open to all Sec 3 students including **G1 students who participated in the Sec 2 HEM Learning Journey to Sembawang in 2025.**
3. Shortlisted applicants may be required to attend an interview.

# Criteria for Shanghai-Hangzhou, China

---

1. Students must possess **fluent Mandarin communication skills**, enabling them to communicate smoothly in both daily and academic settings. This is a necessary condition for participating in this immersive cultural programme.
2. Applicants must **demonstrate a strong interest in Chinese culture** through their CGC Interest Form.
3. Student's Mandarin communication proficiency will be **assessed based on the recommendation of his/her Chinese language teacher**.





# Finance and Funding

---



- Approximate cost per student is between **\$1000 to 1,500** (depending on chosen country) and cost per student to Japan is **\$2,700**.
- School will subsidize **50%** of overall cost of the programme. Only for **Singapore Citizens**.
- **Balance 50%** paid using students **Edusave** account (provided if there is sufficient amount) or by **cash**.
- FAS students will get further subsidies from school.
- For non-SC will be on a case-by-case basis for those in need of financial assistance.

# Example of cost per student on \$1600

	<b>School subsidies</b>	<b>Students payment 50%</b>
Singapore Citizens	50% = \$800	\$800 (edusave / cash)
Singapore Citizens with Financial Assistance	80% = \$800 + \$640 Total = \$1440	\$160 (edusave / cash)
PR & International students	\$0	\$1600 (only in cash) [instalment payments may be arranged]


