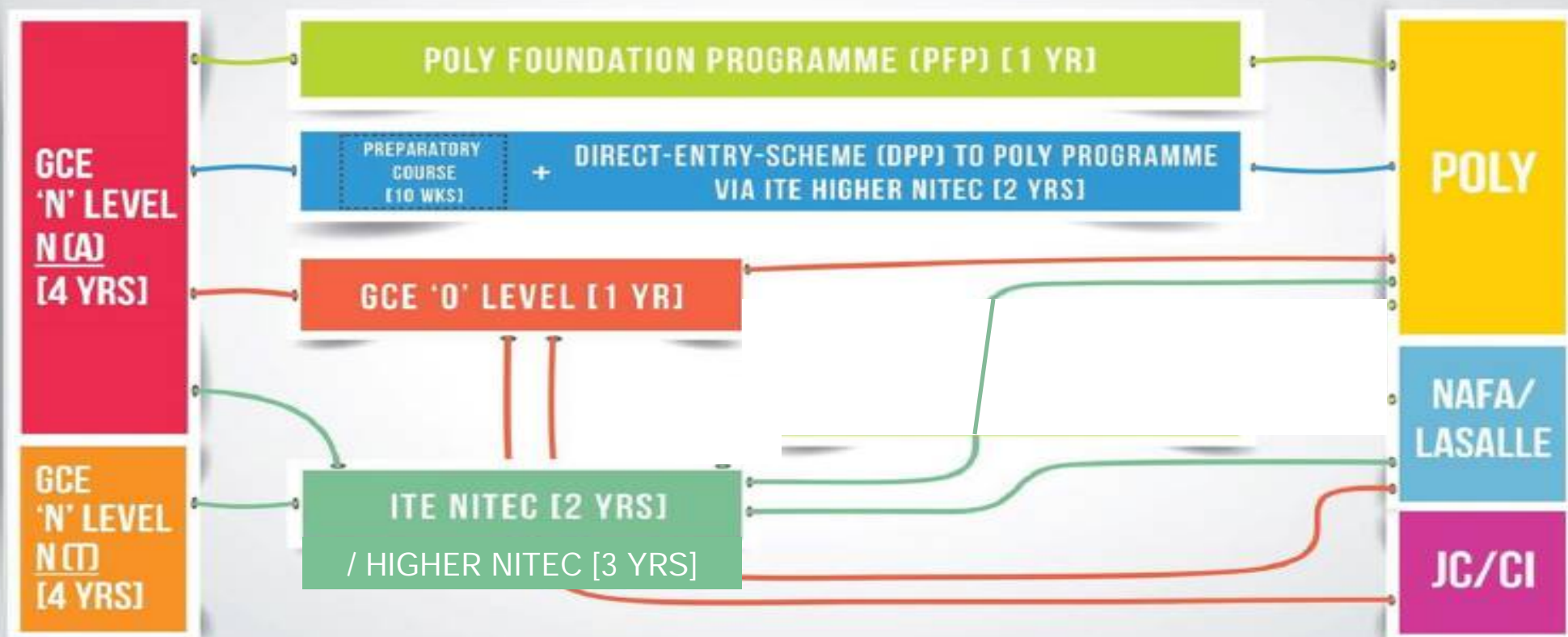


Pathways for 'O' Level Students

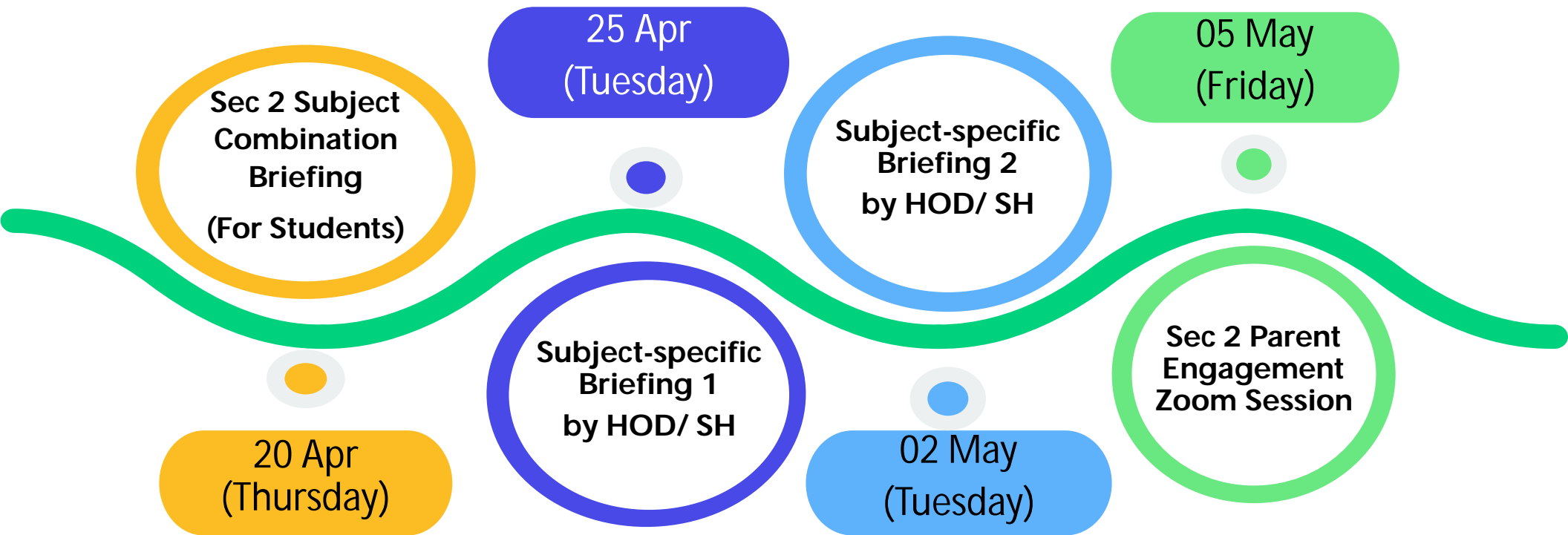

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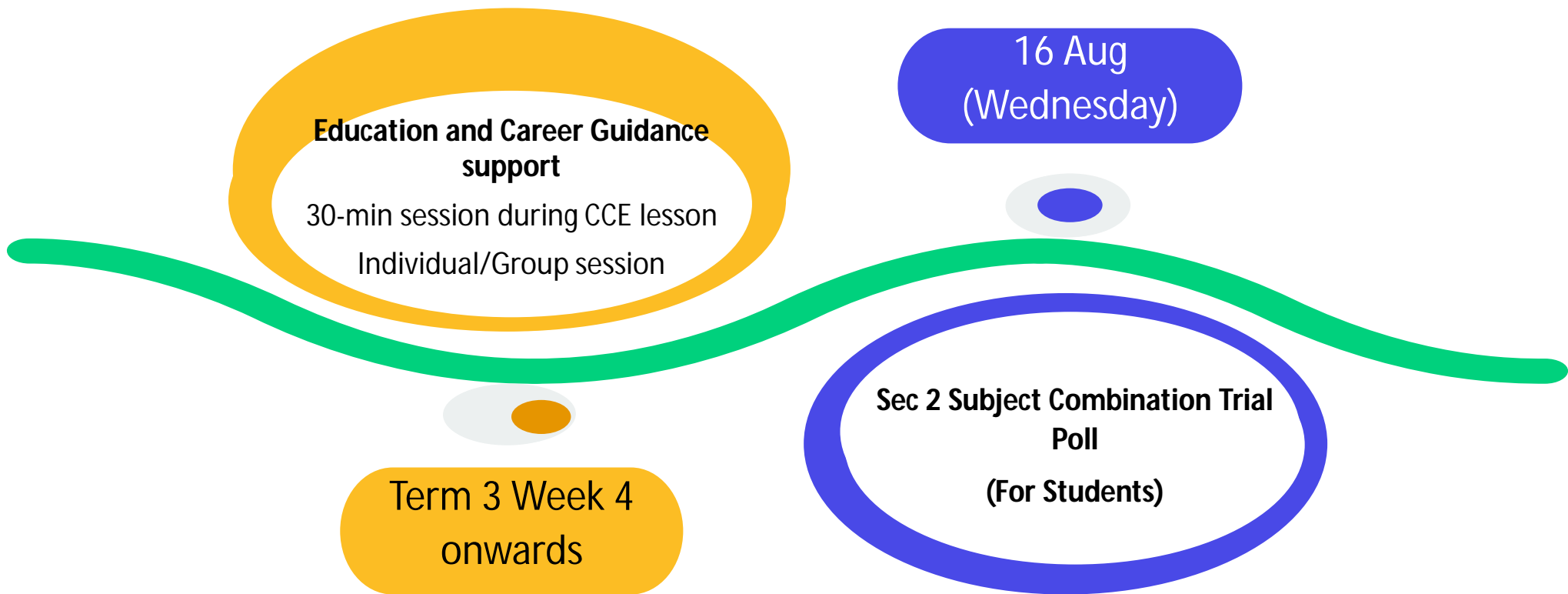
Subject Preference Survey

- A preference survey will be conducted ahead of the actual Subjects Option Exercise to gauge students' interest in each subject combination and to identify internal resources required to support the various subjects.

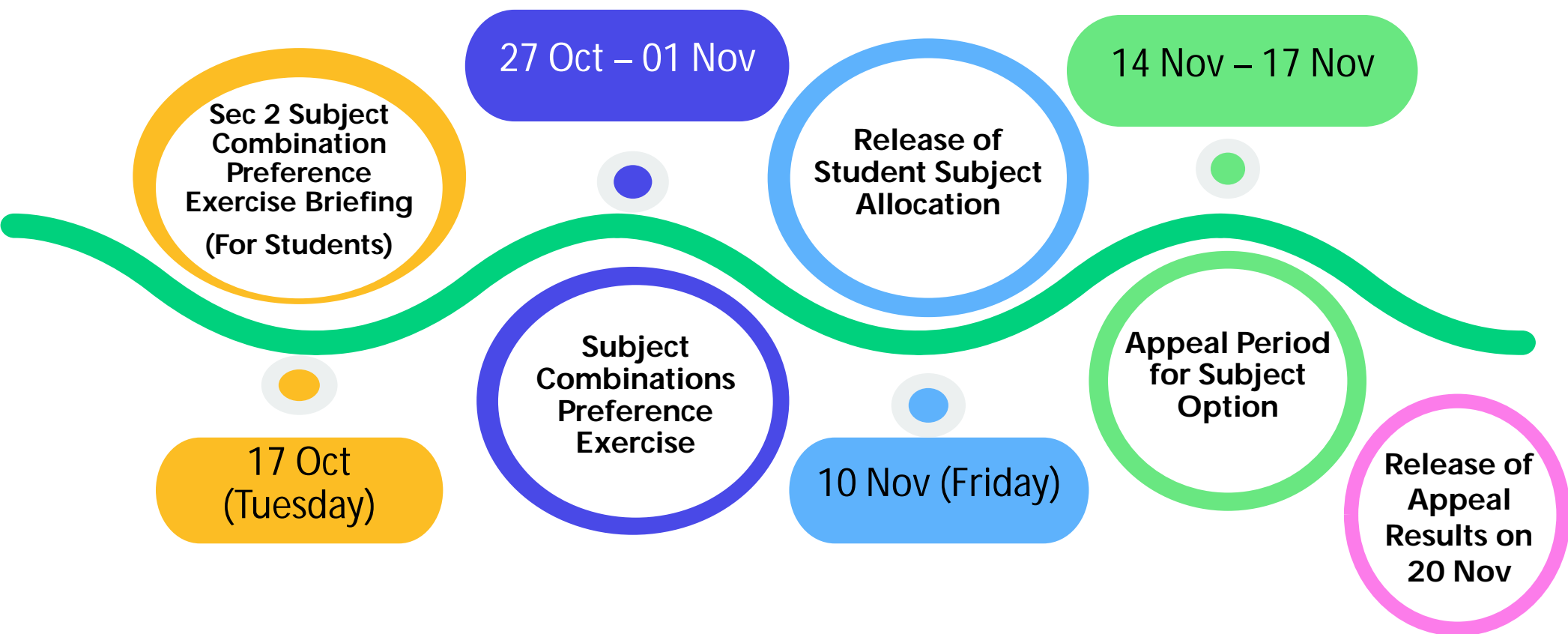
Sec 2 Subject Option Exercise Timeline – TERM 2

Criteria for Subject 7:

- For students who can cope with 7 subjects - Based on subject-specific performance and overall results
- To opt for Geography (7th subject), students must choose a contrasting Elective Humanities (i.e. Social Studies / History) and vice versa




Considerations for Subject Combinations

- Provision of a range of combinations to support the aspirations / interests of students – Every combination has its merits
- Cater to the strengths of students
- Provision of relevant subjects and combination to articulate into post-secondary courses and the workforce
- Aligned to the pre-requisites of post-secondary courses (Junior College (L1R5), Polytechnics (L1R2B2) and ITE)



Subject Allocation

- 
- Subject allocation is based on **merit** and **choice**
 - For Triple Science combination, taking of Pure Sciences and A Mathematics, there will be subject-specific criteria
 - For NA students opting for 7th subject, subject-specific criteria and overall results will be considered
 - Number of classes for a subject combination is not fixed. Classes will be determined based on sufficient students with the **ability** and **interest** who opt for it, and based on availability of school resources

Make Wise Choices...

Options should be based on:

- i) Personal Interest*
- ii) Ability to Cope*
- iii) Future Aspirations and Goals*
