



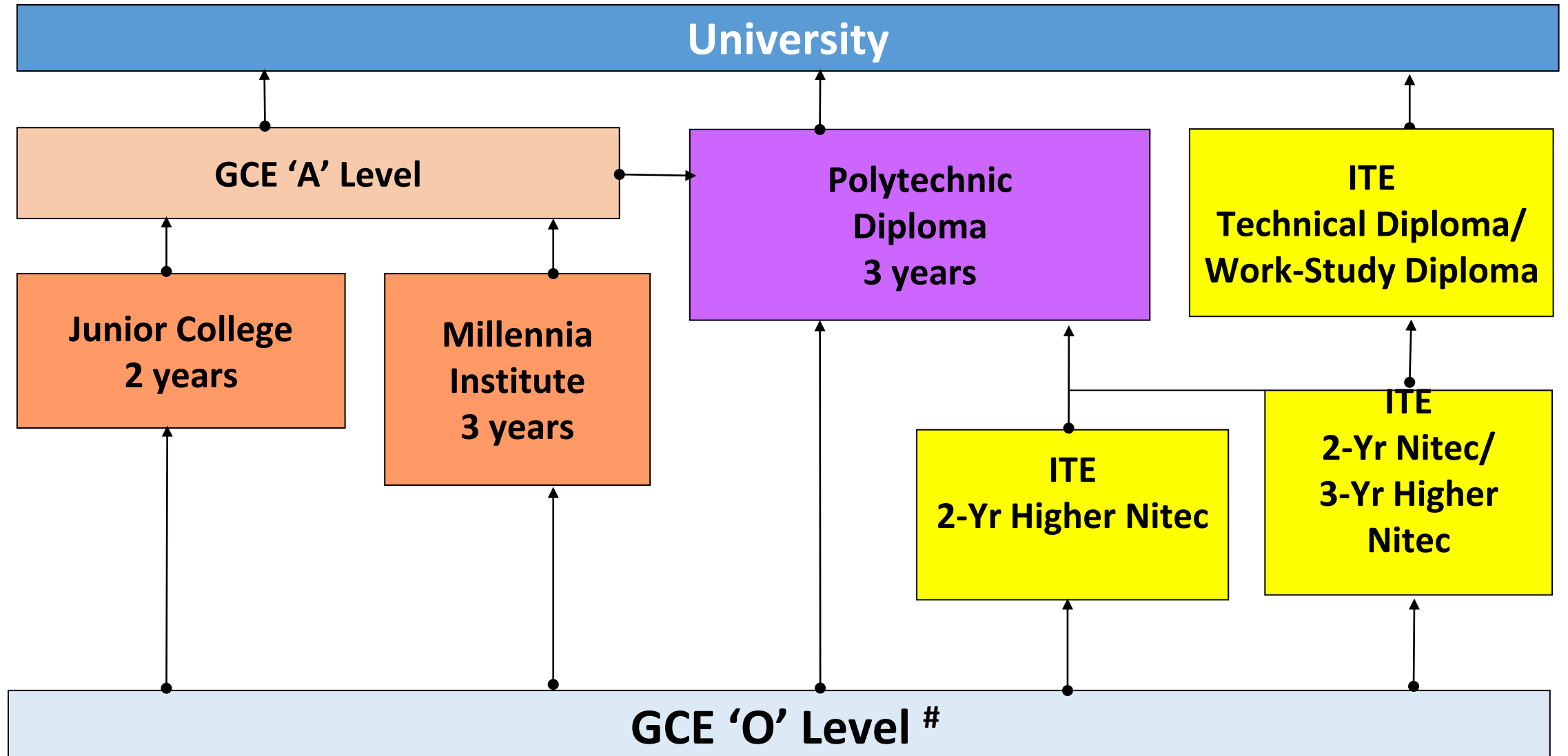

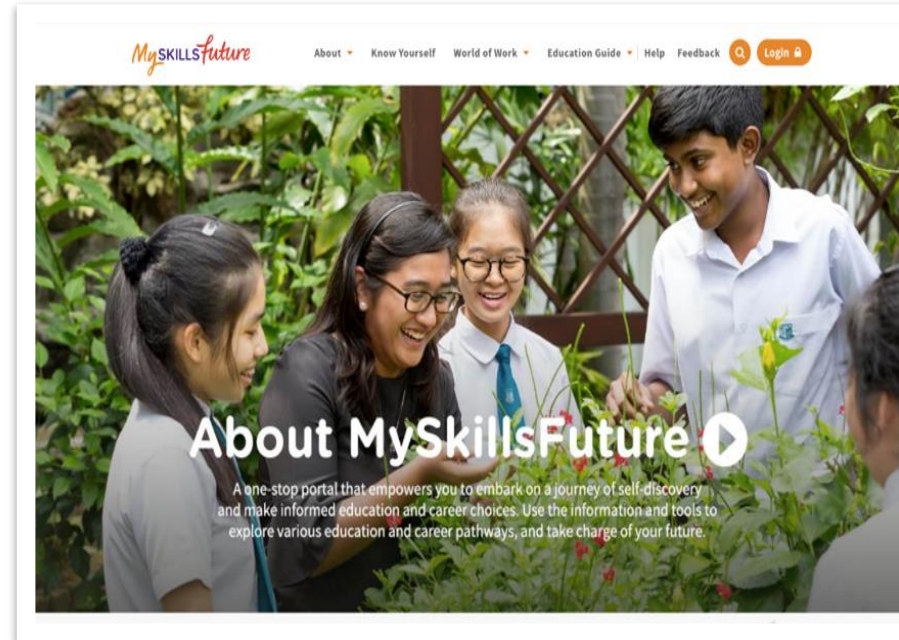

Joint Admission Exercise (JAE)

JC: $L1R5 \leq 20$

MI: $L1R4 \leq 20$ and meet EL, MA, MT requirements.

Consequences of failing certain subjects in O level? Will it affect Poly admission?

Minimum Entry Requirement depends on the course.

E.g. Optometry

Subject	Grade
i) English Language (as 1st Language)	D7*
ii) Mathematics (Elementary / Additional)	C6
iii) Any one of the following subjects	C6
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Biology• Biotechnology• Chemistry• Combined Science• Food & Nutrition / Nutrition & Food Science• Physical Science• Physics / Engineering Science• Science (Chemistry, Biology)• Science (Physics, Biology)• Science (Physics, Chemistry)	

What is the minimum score for polytechnic entry?

And what are the available courses for that minimum score?

Joint Admission Exercise (JAE)

Poly: Net ELR2B2 \leq 26 and meet Minimum Entry Requirement

Diploma in Applied Chemistry/Nursing: Min 26 points

How many bonus points does a child get if they participate in CCA?

CCA grade: **Excellent = 2 Bonus points**

Good = 1 Bonus point

CCA grade are grouped under 4 domains:

Leadership

Achievements

Participation

Service.

In order for student to achieve excellent CCA grade, student need to attain a level 3 for all 4 domains with 1 level 4 in one of the domain.
